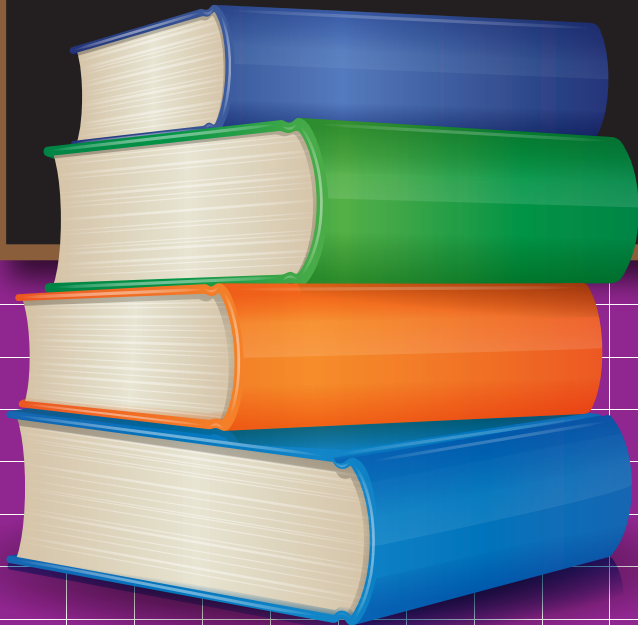

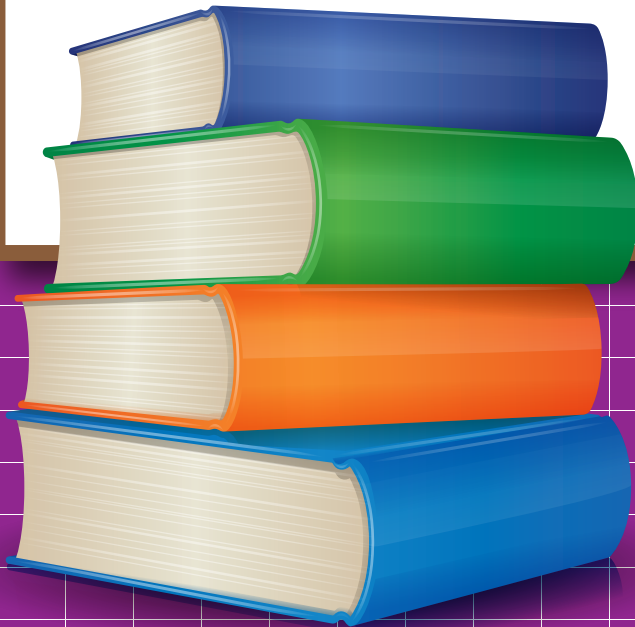

short vowels

Rule: 2 Use a short vowel sound in words that have 1 syllable and end in a silent e. There should be 2 consonants between the silent e and the first vowel.

fence dance

short vowels

Rule: 3 Use a short **o** vowel sound when the letter **a** follows a **w** in a word.

watch swap

short vowels

Rule: 4 Use a short vowel sound in words that end in **dge**.

bad**a**ge hed**e**ge fud**u**ge

long vowels

Rule: 5 Use a long vowel sound in words that end in a single vowel.

hi my go

long vowels

Rule: 6 Use a long vowel sound in words that end with a silent e and have one consonant in between the silent e and the vowel.

slime mane hope

long vowels

Rule: 7 Use a long vowel sound in words that end with **gh, nd, ld, ll, or st** and have an **i** or an **o** before it.

most old thigh

vowel digraphs

Rule: 8 A digraph is when 2 vowels come together to make one sound. Usually the first vowel is long and the second is silent.

rain boat soap

vowel diphthongs

Rule: ¶ A diphthong is when 2 vowels come together to make a new sound.

boy auto blue

r-controlled vowels

Rule: IO When a vowel is followed by a bossy r, the sound is neither long or short.

car her for

letter Y

Rule: Use a long vowel sound in words that have one syllable and end with a **y**. The **y** will have a long **i** sound.

my sky fry

letter Y

Rule: 12 The **y** makes a long **e** vowel sound when a word has at least 2 syllables and ends with a **y**.

baby city

letter C

Rule: 13 The letter **c** will make an **s** sound if the letters **e, i, or y** come after the **c**.

cent **c**ity **c**ycle

letter c

Rule: 14 The letter **c** will make a **k** sound if any letter other than **e, i,** or **y** (or no letter at all) comes after the **c**.

scale magic

letter g

Rule: 15 The letter **g** makes the (juh) sound when followed by the letters **e, i, or y.**

gym giraffe gem

letters dge

Rule: 16 The letters **dge** makes the (juh) sound when at the end of a one syllable word.

edge budge dodge

silent consonants

Rule: 17 Some words have two consonants and one of the letters is silent.

knight comb bright

consonant digraph ch

Rule: 18 ch can make the sound of k when it is close to the letter r.

chrome Chris anchor

consonant digraph ch

Rule: 19 ch can also make the sh sound.

Rule: 10 When a vowel is followed by a bossy r. The sound is neither long or short.

car her for

vowel diphthongs

Rule: 9 A diphthong is when 2 vowels come together to make a new sound.

boy auto blue

letter Y

Rule: 12 The y makes a long **e** vowel sound when a word has at least 2 syllables and ends with a **y**.

baby city

letter Y

Rule: 11 Use a long vowel sound in words that have 1 syllable and end with a **y**. The **y** will have a long **i** sound.

my sky fry

letter c

Rule: 14 The letter **c** will make a **k** sound if any letter other than **e, i, or y** (or no letter at all) comes after the **c**.

scale magic

letter C

Rule: 13 The letter **c** will make an **s** sound if the letters **e, i, or y** come after the **c**.

cent city cycle

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Rule: 16 The letters **dge** makes the (juh) sound when at the end of a one syllable word.

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Rule: 15 The letter **g** makes the (juh) sound when followed by the letters **e, i, or y.**
